What are Colours

Colours are characters of things that result from the light. When the light is on something it reflects or gives off colours, which our eyes see. Colours and different tones of colours help our eyes to recognize or perceive the object. Without light the colours don't really show, because they have no light to reflect off them. There are many types of colours and also warm and cool colours. A warm blue has more red in it, which makes it a slightly darker blue. Cool blue is when there is more yellow in it, like a turquoise or ocean blue. Warm red has more yellow in it, like an orange/red. Cool red has more blue in it and makes a light, hot or medium pink when mixed with white, it depends on how much white is added. Warm yellow has more red in it and cool yellow has more blue in it, which makes the yellow more of an acid colour.
