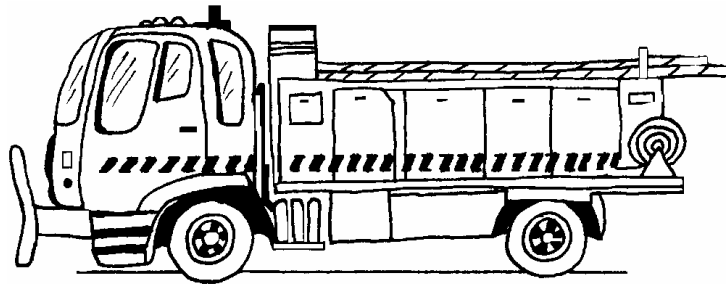

(e.g. with, under, on)



Example: The truck is on the road. The word 'on' is a preposition.
