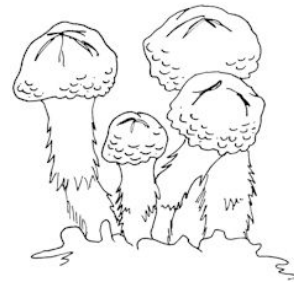
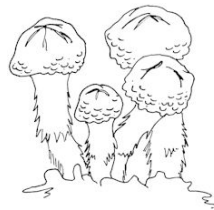

Did you know that fungi can be found in the air, in soil, in water, on plants and even in the human body? When a fungus that is harmful lives in or on the human body it is referred to as a fungal pathogen. Use a dictionary to find out what a pathogen means, write the meaning on the lines below.
