## Teacher Note / Answer Key

2. Venus - 108.2
3. Earth - 149.6
4. Mars - 227.9
5. Jupiter - 778.3
6. Saturn - 1426.8
7. Uranus - 2869.4
8. Neptune - 4496.3
9. Pluto - 5900.1

Create a poster using the sun, moon and stars or make a poster that displays the 9 planets in relation to the sun.
