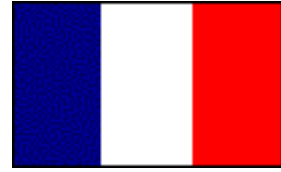

Wallis and Futuna Islands

Wallis and Futuna Islands are a French overseas territory located in the Pacific Ocean west of Samoa. It has an area of 274 km² (106 sq mi). The territory comprises of two groups of islands, Iles de Hoorn and Wallis Archipelago. Main agricultural products are copra, cassava, yams, taro root, and bananas.
